



## TECK REGIONAL SNOW CAMP (KOOTENAY)

Welcome to the 2025 Teck Regional Snow Camp (Kootenay) at Black Jack near Rossland! We respectfully acknowledge that we live, work and play on the traditional, ancestral, and unceded territories of the Sinixt, Syilx, Secwépemc and Ktunaxa First Nations. We honour all other Indigenous people who walked on and care for these lands before us and continue to do so. We are excited to have Kootenay region athletes, coaches, volunteers, and families here at Black Jack for a great weekend building our skills, having fun and training!

We are planning camp activities at both our Main Trailhead and Biathlon Trailhead. However, if snow levels are low from the Main Trailhead at the time of camp, all the camp snow activities will move to Biathlon Trailhead.

<b>Camp Fee:</b>	<p>The Camp fee is \$125.  This fee includes all camp scheduled activities, snacks, Friday evening supper, Saturday evening supper and social event, use of Black Jack facilities, and trail passes. All athletes, coaches, and volunteers will be responsible for their own breakfast, lunch and supplementary snacks.  Black Jack would like the camp to be as inclusive as possible, therefore if you feel you need a discount to attend, please enter the code "SUPPORT2025" in the discount code box on Zone4 and \$40.00 will be deducted from your camp fee, honors system please.</p>
<b>Athlete Eligibility:</b>	<p>Athletes aged 9-17 at the time of the camp are welcome to attend. Headbands will be available to all athletes 16 and under at registration.</p>

<p><b>Coach and Volunteer Registration:</b></p>	<p>We are looking for volunteer coaches with their CC Trained, L2T Trained, or T2T Trained and above qualifications. Coaches will also receive 3 PD Points towards their Maintenance of Certification. Volunteers and coaches will receive a supper meal ticket each day they volunteer to a maximum of two suppers. Volunteers and coaches will also receive complimentary trail passes if they are volunteering on snow on the days they volunteer.</p>
<p><b>Accommodations</b></p>	<p>Accommodations are the responsibility of the attendees. However, we have arranged preferential rates at the Nowhere Special Hostel located just down the road from Black Jack at Red Mountain Resort. There are a few private rooms with queen beds available and also several 8-person dorm rooms and one 10-person dorm room. <p><b>Transportation</b></p>	<p>Travelling between event locations will be your own responsibility, but carpooling will be allowed and encouraged. Please be aware that there may be times when there are two sessions in different locations in the same morning. Please arrive at the location for each event ready to ski at the start time.</p>
<p><b>Meals</b></p>	<p>Tickets for Friday and Saturday supper will be available for purchase for \$15/each for those who would like a meal but are not participating in the camp or receiving a volunteer meal ticket.  Please note that the meals included with the camp are prepared by volunteers. Dietary restrictions will be accommodated unless the complexity of adapting the meal exceeds the capacity of our volunteers. However, please consider the possibility of cross-contamination when deciding whether you or your athlete should participate in the meal.  Please bring your own clean, reusable cutlery to reduce waste. Also, there is no running water available at Black Jack. We ask that you fill up your bottles at your accommodations, though we will have some water available for refills.</p>

- outdoor clothes for all weather conditions
- homework
- yoga mat
- small backpack
- personal toiletry items, including a towel
- water bottles, filled, including something you can bring with you on the trails
- medical number
- cutlery, bowl and plate for dinners
- food for breakfast, lunch, and supplementary snacks
- swimsuit (optional - if your accommodations have a hot tub)
