<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	This race is designed to appeal to racers of all levels, from children and their parents just starting out to advanced racers.
<b>BCWG ELIGIBILITY</b>	<p>Athletes trying out for the BC Winter Games must have been born in 2012 (U14-2) or 2011 (U16-1) and must be a member in good standing of a Zone 3, 4 or 5 club. Athletes born in 2012 may compete in the 2012 or 2011 age categories. Athletes born in 2011 must compete in the 2011 age category.</p> <p>Para skiers of all ages are welcome. Those para skiers born between 1990 and 2012 are eligible to qualify for BCWG.</p> <p><b>Indigenous Participation Program</b>                  Cross Country BC in partnership with the Indigenous Sport, Physical Activity &amp; Recreation Council (I-SPARC) and the BC Games Society will be offering an Indigenous participation initiative for the Trail/ Rossland 2026 BC Winter Games. Up to eight athletes, two coaches and</p>

	<p>two officials with Indigenous ancestry will be eligible to attend the Games. These spots are in addition to the number of athletes and coaches that are already permitted to attend the Games. The selection criteria for the Indigenous positions are listed in the BC Winter Games Technical Guidelines.</p>
<b>LICENCES</b>	<p><b>ALL</b> participants must purchase a Tier 3 Event License regardless of whether they hold an FIS Licence, Nordiq Canada Race Licence, Development Licence, or Associate Race Licence.</p> <p>This license will only be valid for the competition day for which it is issued and will automatically be added to all race registrations on Zone4.</p>
<b>REGISTRATION</b>	<p>Registration is only through <a href="#">Zone4</a>. Please review the confirmation list after registration to ensure that participants are correctly registered.</p> <p>Coaches must also register through <a href="#">Zone4</a>. No fees are required.</p>
<b>DEADLINE</b>	<p>Entry deadline <b>Wednesday, December 31 , 2025 at 11:59 p.m. (midnight)</b></p> <p><b>LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.</b></p>
<b>TRAIL FEES</b>	<p>All racers must have a Whistler Olympic Park (WOP) trail pass for the day of the race. These are not included in your race registration fee but can be purchased at an event discount fee during race registration.</p> <p>Skiers with a WOP season pass do not need to purchase a day pass but will need to present their season pass to gain entry to the Park.</p>
<b>CANCELLATIONS</b>	<p>Any advance cancellation of the event will be by Cross Country BC in consultation with the organizing committee.</p> <p>A decision to cancel the competition or races for a specific age category due to race conditions during an event will be made by the Chief of Competition in consultation with the race organizers.</p>
<b>REFUNDS</b>	<p>In the occurrence of cancellation by race organizer, a refund of registration fees less administration and event expenses already incurred will be provided post-event. No refunds will be made if an athlete does not participate in the race. Zone4 online booking fees are non-refundable.</p>
<b>COURSE MAPS</b>	<p>Course maps are posted online. Check <a href="#">here</a> for the link to the maps.</p>
<b>DRAW</b>	<p>There is no seeding for this event. A random draw will occur on Friday, January 2, 2025.</p>
<b>START LISTS</b>	<p>Start lists will be posted no later than 12:00 pm Saturday, January 3, 2026 on Zone4.</p>
<b>BIB PICKUP</b>	<p>Individual bib and timing chip pick-up will be in the stadium at the entrance to the start area. Athletes should collect their bib and timing chip 15-30 minutes prior to start time. Bibs not picked up will be marked DNS.</p>
<b>WAXING POLICY</b>	<p><i>Cross Country BC has adopted a No-Fluoro policy for all age categories at all Teck Regional Cup races.</i> Please see <a href="#">CCBC Protocol Regarding the Use of Fluorinated Waxes</a>.</p>

<b>WARM UP</b>	A warm up area will be available in the vicinity of the race start.								
<b>WAXING</b>	Waxing trailers are available for rent at Whistler Olympic Park at a rate of \$50.00 per day. Please contact the <a href="#">Race Office</a> for wax cabin requests.
