Eligibility: Athletes trying out for the BC Winter Games must be born in 2012 (U14-2) or 2011 (U16-1) and must be a member in good standing of a Zone 8 club. The zone representatives will be in touch in the week following the qualifier race.

Indigenous Positions: Up to eight athletes with Indigenous ancestry will be eligible to attend the Games. These spots are in addition to the number of athletes that are permitted to attend the 2026 BC Winter Games.

Licenses: All participants must purchase a \$3.00 Nordiq Canada Event Licence.

Race Entry Deadline: Tuesday December 30, 2025, at 11:00 PM
Registration on [Zone4](#) No late entries will be accepted.

Draws/Seeding: There is no seeding for this event, a random draw will occur on Wednesday December 31, 2025.

Start lists/ Results/Bib Pickup:

Start lists will be posted on zone4 on Friday January 2nd and at the Nordic lodge on the morning of the race. There will be an online coaches meeting will be Friday, January 2, 2026, at 6pm a link will be emailed to all coaches. Bibs will be distributed at the Day Lodge on Saturday January 3, 2026, between 9:00 & 9:30 am.

Facilities: A day lodge with First Aid and indoor washrooms is on site.

Food & Drinks: Williams Lake Nordic Club will be hosting a concession serving soup, buns and baked goods

Awards: There will be awards for skiers in the stadium near the finish area after all the races have finished.

Athletes U7 and under - Teck participation ribbon for all

Athletes U8 years to U16 - Teck medals for top 3 finishers, Teck ribbons: 4th & 5th

Athletes U17 and up - awards/prizes will be provided by the Williams Lake Nordic Club

Club Aggregate Award: Club points are accumulated for each race in the Northern Cup Series and an award is given to the club with the most points at the end of the final race of the season.

Waxing:

Outdoor electrical outlets are available outside of lodge. You will need to bring your own equipment. Adherence to this protocol is the responsibility of coaches, parents and wax techs CCBC & Nordiq Canada Rule prohibits the use of all Fluorinated Waxes for Tier 3 events. Weather: Current on-site weather conditions and temperatures can be found on the club's website. For local area conditions visit environment Canada weather page for WL Airport Races will be cancelled or postponed if temperature conditions are unsuitable at start time. Notice will be posted on the event webpage.

With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. With competition distances greater than 15 km and temperature less than -18°C without wind factor, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition.

Course Inspection/Wax Testing:

The racecourses will be marked and open for inspection by noon Friday January 2, 2026. Course maps will be posted at the venue and on the event website as soon as they are available. Course distance/laps may be subject to change. The courses will close 15 minutes before the race starts.

Trail Passes:

Trail passes are included with race fees for all competitors which includes the pre-ski on Friday January 2, 2026, and for the day of the event.


Cancellation Policy:






Teck Northern Cup 3 / BC Winter Games Trials (Zone 8 Northeast) 1.0 km Race Route (U8 - Yellow)







Course 3.0km Climb 46m Decent 46m Climb Dist 776m Decent Distance 739m

Teck Northern Cup 3 / BC Winter Games Trials (Zone 8 Northeast) 3.0km Race Route (U10+U12 - Red)



